Who is served The Family Resource Center (FRC) of Academy School District 20 (ASD20) is a food pantry and clothing closet open to families having children enrolled in ASD20 schools. Clients in need are referred to the FRC by school principals, teachers, and word of mouth. In addition to providing food and clothing, the FRC connects families in need with housing, employment, and mental health resources in Colorado Springs. Forty to fifty families consistently visit the Family Resource Center each week

(2) Providing mental health support for students and families with limited access. (3) Provide referrals and information for community services and wrap around services.
